Stanley K. Lacy Executive Leadership Series Announces Members of Class XXXIII *Bart Peterson to serve as Moderator*

INDIANAPOLIS — Twenty-five young executives have been selected to participate in Class XXXIII of the Stanley K. Lacy Executive Leadership Series (SKL). Each year, 25 emerging young leaders are selected from a pool of applicants to participate in this highly-competitive program that aims to expand the ranks of community leadership by providing class members with the knowledge and incentive to confront the needs of central Indiana.
